

## **Joint State Action**

The states of Oregon and Washington discussed the following recreational fisheries and took the following actions:

### ***Mainstem Columbia River Recreational Summer Chinook Fisheries***

- Adopted the following fishery:

#### **Tongue Point-Rocky Point Line to Oregon/Washington Border**

Dates: Saturday July 4, 2020 through Wednesday July 8, 2020

Area: Mainstem Columbia River from the Tongue Point-Rocky Point line upstream to the OR/WA Border (upstream of McNary Dam).

Catch Limits: Retention of hatchery Chinook (adults and jacks) is allowed. The daily bag limit is two adult hatchery Chinook. Retention of sockeye and steelhead is prohibited.
